Outreach

- *Thanks to the 200 challenge of non-perishable food items in November we were able to cut our Thanksgiving grocery bill in half.
- *St. Timothy's provided Thanksgiving dinner and extra groceries for 13 local families which included 26 adults, 36 children, and 8 teens.
- *St. Timothy's manned the Salvation Army red kettle and raised \$176.28.
- *From the mitten tree St. Timothy's donated 22 pairs of mitten/gloves and 20 warm hats.
- *Thanks to the generosity of the family of St. Tim's, five local Massillon families were able to have a better Christmas this year. Fourteen children received literally piles of Christmas presents and filed up Christmas stockings and they enjoyed a traditional Christmas dinner with their own families.
- *At the Massillon Candlelight Walk we served out 15 dozen beautifully decorated cookies (by the new St. Tim's cookie fairies) and 10 gallons of spiced apple cider.
- *And what a wonderful treat to listen to the team up of Jay Spencer at the organ and Father George at the piano for some of the most beautiful Christmas carols ever.
